At the same time, the pressure on labour costs (which accounts to 60% of the total cost) is mounting.

"Basically, all installers need to grasp this increasing complexity", says Matthias Wiget, CEO of Eternity. "Installers can no longer compete without a strong software backbone to streamline their increasingly complicated work. From lead to installation, every step in the workflow needs to be digitised. That's where the biggest gains are."
